Policy Acknowledgement and Code of Conduct

- I have read the SCSFSC contract and understand the terms of my contract responsibilities as stated including ice time payments, late fees, volunteer hour requirements and ice show requirements.
- The SCSFSC ice contract may not be transferred, bartered, or sold and is to be used exclusively by the contract skater for an activity of equal, but not greater value, in on ice or off ice activity.
- The SCSFSC reserves the right to cancel scheduled events without liability, other than reimbursement.
- The SCSFSC is not responsible for lost, late, stolen or misdirected mail
- The SCFSCS is not responsible for typographical errors.
- I understand that there are no refunds or credits given for missed contracted ice due to injury.

SCSFSC Skater Policies

- I understand my responsibilities as a USFSA figure skater in relation to Safesport policies including but not limited to policies on locker room, harassment, social media and reporting procedures. www.usfsa.org for safesport handbook
- While on the ice I will show respect to all coaches, skaters, ice monitors and parents at all times. I will not use foul language or temper on the ice or off ice while representing SCSFSC. I will use good sportsmanship anytime I am representing SCSFSC within the ice arena and at competitions.
- I will not interrupt coaches while in a lesson.
- I understand there is no eating, gum chewing, or drinking besides water and sports drinks on the ice.
- I understand I am to use the locker rooms or skate change areas in the rink.
- Ice time is for skating and practice, not visiting. I will use my ice time wisely.
- Proper skating attire is encouraged. No street clothing.
- Skaters in lessons and practicing programs as well as coaches using harness have right of way on the ice.

SCSFSC Parent Policies

- I will encourage sportsmanship and respect by showing positive support for all members, coaches, Board members and officials during all skating events both within our ice arena and outside of our ice arena.
- I understand my responsibilities as a USFSA figure skater in relation to Safesport policies including but not limited to policies on locker room, harassment, social media and reporting procedures. www.usfsa.org for safesport handbook
- I will model for my skater resolving conflicts calmly and peacefully and take any unresolved conflicts to board members for support.
- I will show appreciation and recognize the importance of volunteers and club officials. I will fulfill my responsibility to help my club with membership, special projects, competitions and test sessions.
- I understand and support that SCSFSC is committed to creating a safe and positive environment for members physical, emotional and social development and ensure that it promotes an environment free of misconduct.

Should a parent/member of the club not adhere to the above policies, SCSFSC Board of Directors holds the parent/member accountable and the Board of Directors is empowered to take the necessary action. Actions will vary from verbal warnings to disciplinary hearings before the Board of Directors in accordance with USFSA guidelines that may result in suspension or expulsion from SCSFSC.
