REHEARSALS

Show practices will begin March 28th - April 24th Anticipate 2 practices a week + 1 grand finale practice.

Schedule will be available in Feb, practices will be between 4:30 - 6:30pm weekdays, or 9am - 12pm Saturday mornings .

Skaters must be present at all practices. More than one absence will result in removal from that group number.

No exception! You must get approval from the Ice Show Director if you need your one excused absence.

If you know you have a spring break trip scheduled during rehearsals or other after school activities, please note that on form.

Coaches must receive full cooperation; disruptive or discourteous behavior may result in dismissal from the show.

SKATERS

Must be participating in bridge or group classes through April. Group placement will be determined by your age and level as of 11/17/25. Music, costumes and group placement will be at the discretion of the Show Director.

Skaters are required to skate all 5 shows including the Kiwanis benefit show, which is our official dress rehearsal.

VOLUNTEERS

The show is run by volunteers; therefore, a family member is required to work at 2 shows.

A sign-up genius will be sent out for you to choose which shows you can work. We will assign volunteer positions.

Parents with a skater 10 and under must be safe sport certified and must sign up for one or more locker room shifts.

Please go to www.safesport.org/training to complete training. Volunteers agree to arrive on time for their shift, stay for their entire shift, and perform the duties required of that job. Please do not bring others with you to your shift, including young children.

PARENT MEETING

We will have a mandatory parent meeting in March to hand out costumes and answer all questions regarding being in the show.

PLEASE REVIEW

This is your copy of the Reflections on Ice 2026 guidelines. Please realize your commitment to the upcoming Ice Show.

You are financially accountable for all costumes ordered for you, whether or not you are able to complete the commitment to the show. Reflections on Ice is a volunteer-based show and you must volunteer if you want your child to be in the production. Each family receives one thumb drive/ DVD of the show. Additional thumb drives can be purchased for \$30. Siblings will receive a 10% discount on group numbers. Show costumes can be very short, could consist of only a leotard / bathing suit bottom or a bare mid-section. Altering costumes is NOT allowed, and doing so will result in the skater being pulled from their group. Please, make the show director aware now, before placing your child in a group where a costume like this would be unacceptable to you. We will try our hardest to work with you and find a costume/group number that is acceptable.

Registration Fees Includes Costumes, Ice Costs, Choreography Fees, DVD of show, Afterglow Pizza Party (Skaters 10 and under may bring a guest) Skaters are required to behave in a courteous and cooperative manner at all times during ice show rehearsals and shows while on the ice, in locker rooms and on the rink premises. Failure to do so may result in removal from the show, monetary responsibility for anything that has been damaged or broken, and in the most egregious situations - dismissal from the club.
