

## CHECKLIST FOR ICE SHOW WEEK

Here is a list to help you have a successful show week!

- Most Important - **Check the Schedule for final group practices, run-through night and dress rehearsal.** Make arrangements to deliver your skater to the rink on-time!
- Check the volunteer schedule to make sure you arrive on time.
- Make sure your skaters costumes have all of the items they need – hairpieces, belts, masks, etc. Also hang them up and make sure they look nice (no wrinkles) , make any necessary repairs.
- Mark all costumes/ costume pieces and skate guards with your skater’s name.
- Skate guards must be worn at all times when your skater is not on the ice.
- Check to make sure you have the necessary make-up and hair items such as bobby pins, brush, bun makers, hairspray, gel. Refer to your parent packet for the make-up that is needed.
- Under costume garments i.e. bras, body suit, etc. Put them near their costumes so nothing is forgotten. They should not show under their costume so they may need clear straps. Fancy Dancers in St. Clair Shores has items, as well as Lucy & Ethel in Clinton Twp, RD Dancewear in Sterling Heights, and of course Amazon!
- Tights – are they free of runs? Make sure they are put with the costumes.
- Check your laces on your skates – do they need to be replaced?
- Snacks and drinks for the locker room and during rehearsal should be “clean” – water, crackers – anything that cannot stain their costumes.
- Bring a robe to wear while waiting for their numbers - will keep them warm and keep costumes protected.
- Bring a game or something to keep occupied in between numbers in the locker room. A blanket to sit on with friends is helpful too.
- Club skaters have buddy’s – make sure you bring a special item to wish them well, maybe send a telegram, etc. Any gifts should be clean to protect those costumes! Flowers, gift items will be sold during shows.
- Many skaters use a laundry basket to keep all of their items together.
- Plan to arrive before each show one hour before show-time. Some parents may need to be here earlier for their volunteer position earlier.
